**OUTLINE OF PROJECT.** Remodeling of a 4,000 sf building and construction of a 2,800 sf wood-framed addition to create a withdrawal management facility for the White Earth Reservation. The project will include patient housing, staff offices, and associated support spaces. Site and foundation work, wood building addition and remodeling/construction and MEP are included.

It is the bidder's responsibility to see that emailed, mailed, or delivered Bids are in the hands of the Owner prior to the time of the bid opening.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS. This contract is Federally assisted. The Contractor must comply with the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours Standards. Contracts for work under this bid will obligate the Contractor and Subcontractors not to discriminate in employment practices. Bidders must submit a compliance report in conformity with the President's Executive Order No. 11246.

TERO POLICY AND INDIAN PREFERENCE. The White Earth Reservation TERO policy applies to this project including predetermined wage rates, payroll reporting, Indian Preference, and all other requirements included in the policy. The Contractors shall include a 2% TERO fee based on the total bid amount. This 2% fee shall be included in the base bid and all alternate bids.

BID SECURITY. Each Bid for Material and Labor Bid Packages shall be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a Bidders Bond in a sum equal to five percent of the full amount of the bid, including all add alternates, executed by the bidder as principal and by a Surety Company authorized to do business in this State, conditioned that if the Principal's bid be accepted and the contract awarded to him, he, within ten days after notice of award, will execute and effect a contract in accordance with the terms of his bid and a Contractor's Bond as required by law and the regulations and determinations of the governing Board. Cash will not be accepted. Cashier's checks or certified checks will be accepted. Bid security is not required for Material Supply Only Bid Package submissions. See Instructions to Bidders 00 1000, Art. 7, and Section 00 4100 - Multiple Contract Bid Packages And Bid Forms .

PREBID MEETING. There will be a prebid meeting for prospective Bidders at the project site, on Tuesday, January 20, 2026 at 1:00 PM CST. All those with questions for the Owner and A/E are invited to attend. Attendance at the prebid meeting IS NOT required to submit a Bid for this Project.

THE OWNER reserves the right to waive irregularities, to reject any and all Bids, and to hold all Base and Alternate Bids for a period of 45 days after the date fixed for the opening thereof.
